days before Easter marks the beginning of Lent and, more specifically, Ash Wednesday. Lent is the six week period leading up to Easter & ends with Maundy Thursday, the Thursday prior to Easter Sunday and the day of the Last Supper.

For the six weeks prior to Easter Sunday, the worship carriage in Calvary Lutheran's Narthex will display a trio of crosses. God's plan of salvation for the world included the death of God's son, Jesus Christ, upon a cross. The cross in the worship carriage is mounted on a hill. The hill represents the top of the world. Let's not forget, Jesus was the gift that the Lord gave to the whole world!



The crosses flanking either side of the center cross symbolize the hope of humanity and the promise of Jesus of eternal salvation. When we look at the story of Jesus on the cross in the Gospel of Luke, we learn of two other men, often referred to as thieves, that were being crucified in the same fashion as our beloved Jesus Christ. One of the thieves, mockingly asks Jesus, "Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us." This thief askes to be taken down & so he is. The other thief, however, believes in the innocence of Jesus and His promise. Instead of asking to be taken down to end his suffering, the second thief asks to go with Jesus, "Jesus, remember me when You come into Your kingdom. ~ Luke 23:42 Jesus replies to this faithful believer, "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise." ~ Luke 23:43 How fortunate are we, to be given

the gift of eternal salvation, of a life in heaven that is so much better than the one we live here on this earth? God offers all we have and all we need if only we will believe & ask for his forgiveness. So the table will be set at the end of Lent, on Maundy Thursday, with the objects of God's generosity; the bread and the wine, the body and blood of our beloved Jesus Christ.

#### Reports

Secretaries Report: The December 7, 2023 draft was amended to delete under Business "All these wedding services will be performed at Calvary" MSC Judson/Runyan. The revised secretary's report was accepted MSC Berdahl/Platz Typo corrections to Dan(a) and Erika.

Wayne Pearson presented the finance report. December was an outstanding month for both general (\$122,811.76) and building (\$47,843.80) accounts. On-line giving has increased. The financial report was accepted.

Carol Shellack and Nancy McDowell gave an update on the church directory. There were a few surprises in the task such as: It took longer to do than anticipated; Lack of participation of young families with children; Challenging to find appropriate technology support.

The on-line APP use is good for 3 years; photos can be added or removed. Liz Stone will be the administrator of the APP. Several addresses and phone numbers have changed

without notification to the church office. There were several attempts to "members" who have not responded. A note to remember this when the next directory is produced.

Brian Long gave an update on the Hard Hat Ministry. The group completed over 80 projects in 2023 including 4 large projects. The team has been asked to work on renovation inside the Pregnancy Resource Center. The Hard Hat Ministry will perform the labor and the Center would provide the funding. Brian also emphasized that Hard Hat Ministry will not accept projects that require licensed trade work or contain unsafe conditions (e.g. roofing, electrical, plumbing, public safety code violations).

There was discussion involving combining some of the cores. This will be discussed at future meetings. There was discussion regarding the suggested budgeted financial support of the NW MN Synod. More information will be sought.

The 2024 recommended budget to the January 28 congregation meeting was approved MSC: Randall/Runyan.

The annual meeting agenda was approved MSC: Runyan/Platz (Innovation Core was added to the reports given for the annual meeting).

A Calvary Leadership Workshop for the new council was discussed with more planning needed. A recognized challenge was successfully involving more younger members.

Caring and Outreach: Emphasis on the theme: "Welcome to the Table.

Family: Busy schedule of those involved. "Suds of Service" is going well.

Finance: Report was printed.

**Learning**: Did not meet. **Resource**: Did not meet.

Worship: Did not meet.

Youth: Christmas gathering went well. Blankets for kids who need them were prepared.

Innovation: Report was given.

Adjourned at 7:15 with the Lord's Prayer.
