Trust Like Joseph

Life doesn't always unfold the way we expect. We make plans, imagine the future, and picture a smooth path forward, but then something happens to disrupt it. A relationship shifts, a dream falters, or an unexpected responsibility lands squarely in our lap. It's in these moments that faith is tested, and the choices we make may define who we become.

The nativity story captures this tension. Before there are angels, shepherds, or a manger, there is Joseph facing a life that suddenly looks nothing like the one he planned. Matthew tells us simply, "When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him." (Matt. 1:24). With just one sentence, Scripture reveals a profound act of faith. Joseph chose trust.

He trusted that God was present in the disruption of his life. He trusted when his carefully imagined future unraveled. He chose a path that would bring misunderstanding, whispered accusations, and lifelong questions. He chose to stand beside Mary when walking away would have been easier. He chose to raise a child who was not biologically his own. He chose obedience, not because it was simple or safe, but because it was faithful. Joseph's story may start to sound a lot like ours.

Most of us don't face angels in dreams, but we do face Joseph-like moments...times when life doesn't go according to plan, when expectations collapse, when the road ahead feels unfamiliar and uncertain. Often the choice before us isn't between right and wrong, but between what makes sense and what requires trust.

Sometimes faith looks like choosing compassion when judgment would be easier. Sometimes it looks like standing by someone when walking away would protect our reputation. Sometimes it looks like telling the truth when silence feels safer. Sometimes it looks like forgiving when resentment feels justified.

Joseph reminds us that prayer isn't just about asking God to bless the plans we've already made. Prayer is about listening, especially when God interrupts us. Faith isn't having all the answers; faith is trusting that God is present even when the path forward is unclear.

Joseph's story tells us something essential about who God is and how God works. God does not wait for perfect circumstances to come among us. God comes into ordinary mornings and average days and into disrupted lives and into hard choices. God comes into the places where trust feels risky and obedience feels costly.

This is Emmanuel; God with us. God with us in our fear and with us in our uncertainty. God with us in the moments when we don't know what to do next. And like Joseph, we are invited, not to have everything figured out, not to follow our own plan, but to wake up, step forward, and choose trust.


